Origins of Social Media

The first social media platform



Created in 1997, Six Degrees was designed by Andrew Weinreich and is considered to be the first social media platform.

Its sole purpose was to meet friends online. Users could create profiles and share them with one another.

Six Degrees was eventually dominated in the early 2000's by other, more advanced sites like LinkedIn, gmail, and Facebook.


Created in 2004 by Mark Zuckerberg, a Harvard University student. By 2005, Facebook had over 1 million users.

Facebook bought Instagram in 2006 for roughly 750 million and now owns roughly 50 small companies, including WhatsApp and Oculus VR.

Original purpose was for college interaction and to share information


Recently, Facebook has been accused of a "fake news" platform and involved in a data harvesting scandal and hacking scandal.

What Is Fake News?







- Data from your online searches, likes and other data can be used to filter what content you see with the use of things like cookies.




Emotional Responses
